2-3-1 –Definition of Transient Merchant. A transient merchant, other wise called itinerant vendor or peddler, is defined as any person, whether acting as owner, agent, consignee or employee, whether a resident of the municipality or not, who engages in a temporary business of selling, delivering, or offering for sale, good, wares and merchandise and subscriptions within the municipality and who, in furtherance of such purpose, uses, or occupies the streets or alleys or sidewalks of the municipality or any structure, motor vehicle, or other place within the municipality for the exhibition and sale of such goods, wares and merchandise.

2-3-2-Transient Merchant License. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to engage in the business, trade or calling of itinerant merchant within the corporate limits of the municipality, without first having obtained a license to do so.
